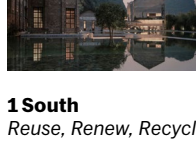

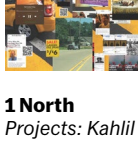

Explore the bold visions for social and environmental sustainability proposed by a new generation of Chinese architects.

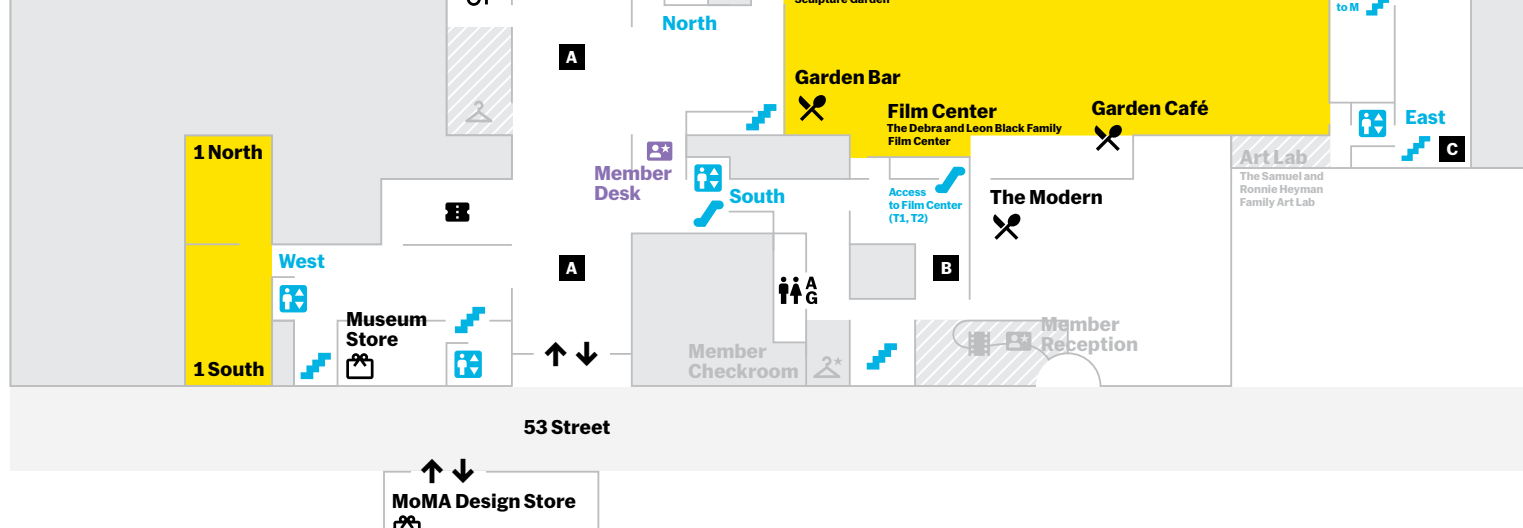

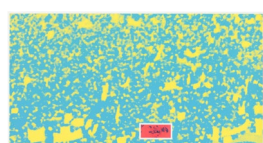

Informed by his travels, memories, and faith, this self-taught artist, at age 71, began making vivid landscape drawings of the world

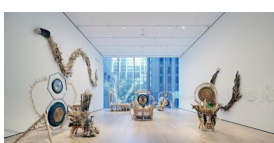
